July has come and gone so quickly, but we praise the Lord for what He has accomplished through us in a such a short time.

Ministry News

Leading up to our Holiday Bible Club, it seemed like everything was against us. The buses had been vandalised, volunteers were saying they couldn't help out last minute, and a former church attender, who did me much evil, contacted me asking to meet up. It was a lot to take on, but by God's grace, we took it a day at a time.

Both buses got written off, but a substantial amount of money was given in exchange. The Lord allowed us to purchase a new bus! We agreed to meet up with the former church member a few days before the HBC and he sat across us in a coffee shop apologising for how he treated us those couple years prior. The Lord brought about forgiveness and reconciliation! Though some planned workers couldn't help, God gave us additional workers elsewhere and provided one of the best HBC we have ever had. We had 166 enrolled that week with over 100 attending each day, close to 1000 verses were memorised that week, and 23 souls came to Christ! That following Sunday, we had two new families start attending our church. The month did not start off the way I had expected, but God brought about an amazing revival in our church. The following week, I preached at a tent meeting in Arbroath and one man asked to talk to someone about how he could be saved. During the first week of August, a fellow missionary hosted a Men's camp and we had five men from our church attend those few days. We received great encouragement that week and the men received a greater zeal for the Lord. We once again had an amazing youth connection with our church teens and children. I truly enjoy building relationships with the young people and pray that God will use them in a great way for His glory.

Sarah is expecting baby #6 in late February. It was quite unexpected, but we are very excited to meet this new addition to the family. She also starts her Ladies' book study on 22nd August. Pray for God's blessings! Madelyn came to our bedroom door late Friday night (8/11) and asked about being saved. After talking for a bit, in tears, she prayed and ask Jesus Christ to save her. All of Heaven rejoiced as another sinner repented. (Luke 15:7) Katelyn has been reading the Bible each evening before bed. Her mind is like steel trap as she absorbs each passage and informs me regarding what she has learned even weeks later. We now have two groups coming next year to help with church renovations. Though I won't stop asking, I believe God is telling me to have more faith.
